CONTRACTUAL ADVANCED PRACTICE CLINICIAN

The Tuscola County Health Department is seeking an Advanced Practice Clinician on a contractual basis to work between 2 and 6 days per month. This position works in the Family Planning and Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) programs under the supervision of and in collaboration with the Medical Director and Nursing Administrator to provide reproductive health services to clients.

Job duties include, but not limited to:

- Obtains and evaluates medical, surgical, family, and social histories of clients
- Provides family planning, gynecological care, and reproductive health care in a clinical setting
- Provides appropriate clinical evaluations and interventions including treatment of sexually transmitted infections
- Prescribes medication within pharmacy law specifications with oversight by Medical Director
- Provides/oversees hormonal contraceptive injections
- Educates the client regarding care, self-care techniques, and preventive strategies
- Documents accurately and timely within an EHR
- Makes referrals and coordinates with community resources/agencies

- Current Michigan licensure (NP, PA, CNM)
- Current CPR certification
- Possess a valid Michigan driver's license
- Satisfactorily pass a drug screening
